Coordinated Entry

How to Access Adult Homeless Services in Boulder County under COVID Restrictions:

Are you a homeless adult (18+) with no children in your household? Do you need a safe place to sleep, shelter, or help with basic needs? Your first step to receiving services from Boulder County is by calling CE. This is a required step for anyone seeking homeless-related services. You will talk with a staff person and go through a short assessment. Based on that information, you will be referred to the most appropriate services given your needs. Services include shelter; help identifying housing options, basic-needs services, and more.

What if I need help after CE hours?

You may go to the Boulder Shelter 5-7pm or call 211 for information on available services. You must complete the assessment at the next available time to access future services.
