

Dear Crestview members,

As the number of Covid-19 cases has increased in our area, Boulder County has instituted more restrictive guidelines than the state of Colorado. Our worship services will once again change to reflect these guidelines. [You can find the Boulder County guidelines here.](#)

The most important change is that we will be requiring sign-ups online for in person attendees. This is the only way to keep our numbers at 50 people in the building. Please be sure to sign up if you want to attend in person. Crestview Indoor Service Guidelines (November 2020):

1. Masks are required indoors at all times for any individuals 4 years and older. NO EXCEPTIONS. Extra masks will be provided at the door if you do not have one. Be sure to properly wear your mask so that it covers your mouth and nose. Note: Speakers may remove their mask while speaking but should stand at the very front of the sanctuary to maintain maximum distancing.
2. There will be only one allowable entrance into the building through the far east doors. Please exit through another set of doors other than the designated entrance. When you enter or exit, please maintain 6 feet distancing between groups.
3. We are required to allow no more than 50 people in the building and maintain 6 feet distancing between groups. For this reason, we will have arranged seating in the sanctuary for groups of 2 and 3 chairs at 6 feet intervals with some additional seating available in the Fellowship hall. If you have more than 3 people in your group you may occupy multiple seating groups, but please do NOT rearrange seating.
4. To maintain the 50 person limit, we will be requiring sign-ups for the service so that we can get a feel for the number of people desiring to attend indoor worship and decide whether we need to provide a second service to accommodate all. 5. Bring your own Bible (BYOB).
6. Do not attend if you are not feeling well, have a new persistent cough, or are running a fever.
7. Restrooms will be available for use for only one person at a time. An attendant will be giving instructions for sanitizing, hand washing, and regulating one person for bathroom use at a time, as well as spot cleaning as necessary.
8. We strongly recommended that those who are at higher-risk of severe illness from COVID-19 continue using online options. Alternatives to attending in person will still be available:
  - watch the service streamed live, or
  - watch the streamed video available after the service, or
  - listen to an audio recording available after the service.

As you approach the sanctuary on Sunday, a greeter will show you a map of the remaining seats in the sanctuary. Feel free to choose an open group of seats of the size you reserved. We are looking to everyone to respect one another by practicing these guidelines. We long for the day we can shake hands and hug each other.

Our prayers are with each one of us that we would love God first and our neighbor as ourselves.
