Lord's Day 20-23:

1 Corinthians 6:19, 2 Corinthians 1:21-22

Q & A 53

Q. What do you believe concerning "the Holy Spirit"?

A. First, that the Spirit, with the Father and the Son,
is eternal God.
Second, that the Spirit is given also to me,
so that, through true faith,
he makes me share in Christ and all his benefits,
comforts me,
and will remain with me forever.

Q & A 56

Q. What do you believe concerning "the forgiveness of sins"?

A. I believe that God,
because of Christ's satisfaction,
will no longer remember
any of my sins
or my sinful nature
which I need to struggle against all my life.
Rather, by grace
God grants me the righteousness of Christ
to free me forever from judgment.

Q & A 60

Q. How are you righteous before God?

A. Only by true faith in Jesus Christ.
Even though my conscience accuses me
of having grievously sinned against all God's
commandments,
of never having kept any of them,
and of still being inclined toward all evil,
nevertheless,
without any merit of my own,
out of sheer grace,
God grants and credits to me
the perfect satisfaction, righteousness, and holi-
ness of Christ,
as if I had never sinned nor been a sinner,
and as if I had been as perfectly obedient
as Christ was obedient for me.
All I need to do
is accept this gift with a believing heart.
